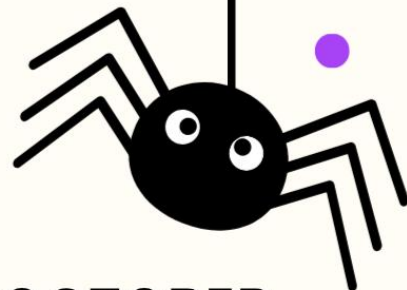
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Infant A-1 Ms. Kalia & Ms. Toni
